Day 1: Place of Origin - Barcelona, Spain

Prepare your luggage and bags full of hope today, take a luxury airliner to Barcelona, Spain, and start a warm and relaxing trip to the Western Mediterranean.

Day 2: Barcelona, Spain

After the flight arrives in Barcelona, after the pick-up, the car will go to the pier to prepare to board the cruise ship, and start a romantic and leisurely journey to the western Mediterranean.

Day 3: Palma, Spain Tour time: about 7 hours

Sóller is located in a valley in the Tramontana Mountains in the northwest of Mallorca, surrounded on three sides by olive orchards and orange orchards, and on the other side is a beautiful bay, a small island facing the Mediterranean Sea. Town, is a famous tourist destination in Mallorca. Then return to Palma to visit Bellver Castle, Palma Bullring, and finally visit the outside of Palma Cathedral, then drive back to the cruise ship.

Day 4: Provence (Marseille), France Tour time: about 5 hours

The cruise ship arrived in Marseille, France in the morning. Day 5: Florence/Pisa (La Spezia), Italy Tour time: about 9 hours

The cruise ship arrived in La Spezia, Italy in the morning. After disembarking, we were greeted by a special car and headed to Florence/city sightseeing. Florence is considered to be the birthplace of the Renaissance, one of the cradles of art and architecture, with many historical buildings and museums with rich collections. Many cultural celebrities were born and lived here in history. The historic center of Florence is listed as a World Heritage Site. Visit Piazza Duomo, Piazza della Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, Piazzale Michelangelo. In the afternoon, take a special car to Pisa, and take pictures at the Leaning Tower of Pisa, one of the world-famous architectural wonders and one of the symbols of Italy, in the Piazza dei Miracoli. Then drive back to the cruise ship. Breakfast and dinner on the cruise ship, lunch on your own arrangement

Day 6: Rome (Civitavecchia), Italy Tour time: about 9 hours

The cruise ship arrived at Civitavecchia in the morning. After disembarking, we were greeted by a special car and headed to Rome, entered the Vatican to visit St. Peter's Basilica, then went to the Colosseum, one of the new seven wonders of the world, to take pictures, and then visited the Pantheon. Head to the Trevi Fountain for a photo stop. Finally, enjoy free time at the Spanish Steps lined with famous shops. Then drive back to the cruise ship.

Breakfast and dinner on the cruise ship, lunch on your own arrangement

Day 7: Naples (Capri Island), Italy Tour time: about 8 hours

The cruise ship arrives in Naples, Italy in the morning. After disembarking, a special car will greet you and head to Sorrento. The city is built on a cliff by the sea, surrounded by trees such as oranges, lemons, olives and mulberries. It is a beautiful tourist area. It mainly produces wine and olive oil, and fishing is also important. Fine wood inlay, lace and other handicrafts are famous. In the afternoon, head to Pompeii. Pompeii was founded around 600 BC on a hill on the banks of the Sano River in Italy. In 79 AD, a week after several earthquakes and other signs of volcanic activity, Mount Vesuvius erupted, burying Pompeii alive under volcanic ash overnight. Then drive back to the cruise ship. Breakfast and dinner on the cruise ship, lunch on your own arrangement

Day 8: Sea Cruise

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The cruise ship sails at sea all day, group members can enjoy various facilities on board and taste delicious food

Day 9: Barcelona, Spain - Place of Origin

In the morning, the cruise ship will arrive in Barcelona. After breakfast, disembarkation procedures will be completed, ending the Mediterranean cruise. After disembarking, we will be greeted by a special car and head to Barcelona Cathedral and Montjuic Mountain overlooking the panoramic view of Barcelona to take pictures. Then head to Montserrat Mountain and visit Montserrat Monastery. The monastery is the most important religious sanctuary in Catalonia. The statue of Our Lady of Montserrat enshrined in the monastery is the favorite patron saint of the Catalans. In the afternoon, head to Park Guell, one of the breathtaking works of architect Gaudí, listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Later, the famous Sagrada Familia, designed by Gaudí for its towering and unique design, has become the most well-known tourist attraction in Barcelona. Gaudí took over the design and construction of the Sagrada Familia in 1883. Until now, this building is still under construction. It is the only building in the world that has not been completed and is listed as a World Heritage Site. After the trip, transfer to the local luxury hotel in the city center for check-in.

Breakfast on the cruise ship, lunch and dinner on your own arrangement

Day 10: Barcelona, Spain - Place of Origin

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport at the designated time for your flight back to your hometown.
